

Trinity

In the concept of the Trinity we have three distinct personalities known as God. The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Father is not Jesus or the Holy Spirit, Jesus is not the Father or Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit is not the Father or Jesus. But all three are referred to in the scriptures as God.

Jesus cannot be thought of as a god for Isaiah tells us:

- Isaiah 43:10 *Before me there was no god formed, neither shall there be after me.*
44:6 *I am the first, and I am the last; beside me there is no god.*
44:8, 45:5, 6, 21 *Besides me there is no god*
46:9 *I am God and there is none like me.*

Jesus is not an angel

- Heb 1:5 *Unto which of the angels said he at any time thou art my son.*
1:8 *God calls Jesus his God*
2:5 *He took not on him the nature of angels. If he was an angel, he would not have this statement about himself.*
2:5 *The world is not in subjection to an angel*
1:6 *All the angels worshiped him. Did he worship himself?*

Jesus is not Michael the Archangel

- Daniel 10:13 *Michael one of the chief princes, Michael was only one of the chief princes, not the only one.*
Jude 1:9 *Michael dared not come against the devil but said the Lord rebuke you. Jesus could come against the devil at any time.*
